**Re: AB 2314 - Urge Signature**

Dear Governor Brown,

On behalf of the California Women's Law Center (CWLC), we write to urge your signature on AB 2314, which creates the Domestic Work Enforcement Pilot Program at the Division of Labor Standards Enforcement. The Pilot Program will increase awareness and enforcement of existing laws while promoting higher standards in the domestic work industry.

Domestic workers are primarily women of color and often immigrants. AB 2314 will help protect domestic workers against retaliation by unfair employers. Additionally, the Pilot Program would improve the economic security of domestic workers and their families by protecting basic worker rights and increasing the likelihood that workers receive fair wages.

CWLC's mission is to advance the potential of women and girls through transformative litigation, policy advocacy, and education. For nearly 30 years, CWLC has been helping to secure equality for women in the workplace, with a focus on advocating for low-income workers and women of color. CWLC is dedicated to ending practices contributing to gender discrimination in employment, and ensuring women have the resources and opportunities to advance their careers and receive equal compensation and benefits.

For these reasons, the California Women's Law Center urges your signature on AB 2314.
